Proven Outcomes

- During the 2015 2016 academic year, B.O.B was implemented at Alexander II Magnet School to address the social, emotional and academic needs of low performing male students. 25 students began the program; with a 90% completion rate.
- 72% of students mathematics grades improved from poor performance to above average and beyond.
- 70% of students reading grades improved from poor performance to above average and beyond.
- 100% of B.O.B. participants were promoted to their next grade level.
